As of the Spring Semester of 2017 we will begin moving away from supporting VHS players in the classrooms on the Va. Tech campus. We will keep supplying support VHS technology in the classroom until we can no longer provide reliable players. If you have VHS tapes that you would like to use for teaching, our recommended solution is to convert your class materials to a digital format. Contact the Va Tech Library for information and regulations for this.
